

McCoy College Assessment Committee *Approved* Meeting Minutes

Meeting Date: December 2, 2005: 1-2 pm in DH 111A

1. The agenda for the McCoy College Assessment Committee focused on a review of the Texas State Alumni Survey findings and comparative analysis of findings over the period of 2000 through 2004. Prior to the meeting, committee members were given the printout of data from the 2004 Alumni Survey and the results and observations of the McCoy assessment committee concerning the 2000 and 2002 surveys.
2. The committee reviewed the data from the three alumni surveys to determine trends, potential concerns and significant positive information concerning alumni perceptions. The committee will assemble and publish a report with extracted information for review by faculty in the McCoy College, the McCoy Curriculum Committee, CBAC and other interested constituents. This report will include specific observations and recommendations for continuous improvement. The report should be available for dissemination and faculty review in January 2006.
3. Due to the lack of time, the committee deferred a review of all surveys used in assessment of learning outcomes (indirect assessment measures) until early in the Spring 2006 semester. The committee is in agreement that there are too many indirect assessment surveys administered by the McCoy College and Texas State University (Institutional Research office) and that a few surveys highly stratified to a limited student audience should be reviewed for inclusion in the assessment process.
